STATEMENT OF FAITH



SCRIPTURE

We believe that the Old and New Testaments are the inspired, infallible, and inerrant Word of God, our final authority in matters of doctrine and practice.

GOD

We believe that God is one being—infinitely just, wise, good, loving, holy, and existing eternally in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. He is the sovereign creator of the universe and by his providence sustains and rules all that he has made.

HUMANITY

We believe that people were created in the image of God but fell into sin through the disobedience of Adam and Eve. As a result of the Fall, all people are born sinful and in need of salvation.

JESUS CHRIST

We believe that Jesus Christ is fully divine and fully human and that he saves his people from their sin by his life, death, and resurrection.

SALVATION

We believe that sinners are justified by grace through faith on the basis of the finished work of Christ (his death and resurrection) and persevere in this life by the power of God.

THE HOLY SPIRIT

We believe that the Holy Spirit regenerates sinners, indwells believers, and enables them to live godly lives and to use the spiritual gifts he has given them.

THE CHURCH

We believe that God is calling people from the whole human race to believe in his son, Jesus Christ. They enjoy the protection of God and fellowship with each other in communities of faith until Jesus returns.

THE FUTURE

We believe that Christ is ruling now over the church and the world through his Word and Spirit. He will return to judge the living and the dead and to renew the whole creation.



HISTORY



The rich heritage and unique mission of Kuyper College can be traced to its founding in 1939 as Reformed Bible Institute (RBI). RBI had a very clear focus as an institution to provide solid training in the Bible and preparation for ministry or service. This institution would meet unmet needs within the local community by filling a niche and providing an education in a setting that was neither a liberal arts college or a seminary.

In 1970, after an almost five-year redesign of curriculum and programs, the Department of Education of the State of Michigan gave the school the right to confer a four-year Bachelor degree. As a result, RBI changed its name to RBC— Reformed Bible College. During that time, students came for reasons of personal spiritual enrichment, focused study toward a specific ministry, and development of skills for serving in volunteer roles in the church or service agencies. RBC established the requirement that all four-year graduates would have a major in Bible and Theology as well as a major in their career track. Even then and continuing through today, the college was concerned that its education not be isolated from practical experience so internship opportunities became an important part of the student experience.

In 1995, RBC received North Central Association accreditation, setting the college on the road to higher academic standards to prepare leaders for the church. And in 1997, RBC was granted authority to offer a Bachelor of Science degree, moving the college toward broader ministry, vocational, and ministry-related professional offerings.

On April 20, 2006, as a reflection of Kuyper's mission and vision, and in response to global needs and strategic priorities, the college restated its position and changed its name from Reformed Bible College to Kuyper College. The college has developed from being a Bible college to a ministry-and service-focused Christian leadership college. This "mission-enabling" term accurately describes the unique mission and vocational programs of the college. This term also completely integrates with Kuyper's Reformed worldview and with today's students who desire a well-rounded biblical and vocational college experience that sees all of life as being instrumental in discovering God's glory, communicating these truths to others, and honoring the Lordship of Jesus Christ.

The college continues to build on the strong foundation established first as RBI, and later as RBC. Kuyper has moved from being an institute of Bible, Theology, Evangelism, and Missions to being a Christian Leadership College rooted in developing and applying a Reformed worldview in every area of life: seeing every vocation as a Christian vocation. Today, Kuyper College has a total enrollment of about 250 students and offers a wide variety of degree programs and 15 study-abroad opportunities, each one intentionally designed to meet students' desire to be the "heart and hands" of Christ. The college seeks to place graduates in ministry and professional areas of leadership around the world to meet the spiritual and social challenges that exist today. This is the essence of Kuyper's purpose, the essence of its identity: "Bringing God's grace into today's culture."






KUYPER AT A GLANCE

PRESIDENTIAL PROFILE



THE POSITION

The President of Kuyper College serves as the chief academic, financial, spiritual, and development executive of the institution, exercising overall leadership for the institution. Serving as a non-voting member of the board, the President reports to and is assessed by the college's 13-member Board of Trustees. The President supervises and has jurisdiction over all of the business and affairs of the college, being responsible for the execution of policies and directives of the Board of Trustees and its committees.

The President formulates vision and provides strategic leadership in developing long term initiatives that will advance the mission of Kuyper College. This vision must be translated into clear goals and objectives. The President must be highly effective in articulating, communicating, and championing these goals and objectives to the Board of Trustees, students, staff, and faculty, and to the various stakeholders and constituencies that make up the greater Kuyper community.

The President develops, formulates, and directs policy and governance in accordance with the policies of the Board of Trustees.

Under the current organizational structure, the President's direct reports include the following members:

- Provost
- Vice President for College Advancement & Enrollment
- Vice President for Business and Finance
- Assistant to the President

Typically, the President of Kuyper manages three to five Vice Presidents and/or Directors who supervise a staff of approximately 60 members in operations, admissions, academics, and support.

CHRIST-CENTERED, REFORMED FAITH

- Pursues a deep personal relationship with Jesus Christ and has a strong devotional and prayer life
- Demonstrates mature Christ-modeled leadership, is trustworthy and of impeccable integrity and character
- Participates actively in a local Reformed congregation
- Will value, exhibit, and proactively communicate in word and deed Kuyper's strong spirit of love and respect for one another

EXTERNAL FOCUS

- Must enjoy the external aspects of the role: meeting new people, telling the Kuyper story in a compelling manner, maintaining deep relationships with existing donors, and seeking and developing relationship with new donors—both individuals and foundations
- Must have demonstrated ability to personally—with institutional support—raise substantial amount of funds and identify new sources of revenue
- Build and instill confidence in all the constituencies in the Kuyper community
- Work collaboratively with the Advancement team to understand and prioritize various fund-development strategies
- Collaborate with the Provost to grow cooperative arrangements with other colleges and universities
- Work with the key departmental staff to attract top students, faculty, and staff
- Enthusiastically and effectively communicate Kuyper's mission and vision to all internal and external stakeholders

ACADEMIC AND INSTITUTIONAL VISION

- Will value and protect the heartfelt, inviting, collegial, and professional culture at Kuyper College
- Will lead and motivate the team—inspiring enthusiasm, casting the vision, and envisioning ideas that are appropriate for the college
- Will be passionate about the key areas of Kuyper's focus: Ministry, Youth Ministry, Social Work, Education, Missions, Music and Worship, and Business Leadership
- Will be committed to equipping persons for service in the Church and in ministries and professions throughout the world
- Will be entrepreneurial in strategizing new approaches and partnerships for higher education delivery

- Understands the economics of a higher education institution with a \$5.7 million budget
- Demonstrates ability to consistently assemble, present, and execute balanced budgets in line with fiscal responsibility and sustainability
- Makes decisions demonstrating the ability to thoughtfully and unwaveringly act in a timely manner to steward institutional priorities
- Has a track record of hiring, developing, and retaining a strong senior leadership team
- Is resolute, decisive, and bold on behalf of the long-term interests of the college, with a proven track record of making tough, yet wise decisions with a spirit that goes hand-in-glove with Kuyper's culture

DESIRED BACKGROUND

Kuyper College's next President should have an impressive array of executive leadership and strategic experience and a financial background in leading organizations that face the challenges commonly found in small colleges and universities. An earned doctorate is preferred for this executive position, but consideration will be given to candidates with requisite attributes, qualifications, and experience.

With the principal goal to equip Christians to be transformational leaders—who instilled with a firm faith in God's grace and a commitment to follow His call, effectively serve His church, and advance His kingdom throughout the world the Kuyper community established that the next President of Kuyper will be expected to lead the school community to believe, embrace, work towards, and achieve this vision.

As a college committed to a biblical, Reformed worldview, Kuyper College will be a unique, vital, and engaging learning community, characterized by innovation and excellence in its programs and educational partnerships.

- We will enroll increasing numbers of academically prepared and motivated ministry and service-focused students, and in the Reformed tradition, we will empower each person to discern their spiritual gifts, mature in the understanding of who they are in Christ, and live a vibrant and fruitful life of ministry and service to others

- Our faculty will remain committed to outstanding teaching and scholarship
- We will enhance our reputation as a leading ministry-focused Christian leadership college that prepares its graduates for successful lives of service and ministry-focused endeavors throughout the world
